<p><b>Position for:</b></p> <p><b>FG IV Economic Analyst – Fiscal Policy</b></p>	<p>The Fiscal Policy Analysis unit of JRC (JRC.B2) wishes to recruit an economist to work in the scientific project named "FISCALPOLICY". This project covers the modelling of fiscal reforms with a special focus on inequality and makes use of both micro and macro models. Modelling support will be provided to support Commission assessment of reforms in the EU Member States using and extending JRC.B2 models.</p> <p>The successful candidate will be expected to support the Fiscal policy team for the modelling of fiscal reforms, and to contribute to the research work and scientific activities of the Unit. He/she will be expected to have experience in both macro and micro fiscal modelling and analysis. Expertise in macro-fiscal modelling, including general equilibrium modelling, is a prerequisite. Experience in micro-simulation modelling (for the analysis of tax and social benefits reforms) and a good command of software such as Stata or equivalent would represent key additional assets. Research and analytical tasks will involve collaboration with European Commission services and other relevant international organisations and research institutions.</p> <p>Candidates should have a PhD (doctoral diploma) or a minimum of 5 years professional experience after university studies of at least 3 years attested by a diploma. A good level of written and spoken English is essential.</p>
