The EUROMOD model covers personal income taxation, social security contributions and social benefits for the 28 EU Member States. The objective is to ensure the handling of technical issues related to the internalisation of the EUROMOD model currently based at the University of Essex.</p> <p>The successful candidate will collaborate with the project manager on technical issues in the coordination of tasks with ESTAT and EUROMOD national teams and the duties will include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Supporting and monitoring the transfer of the source code and development environments of the EUROMOD executable and user interface from the University of Essex to JRC Seville.• Planning of activities in relation with the maintenance, updates and improvement of EUROMOD.• Performing technical and functional assessment and designing the updates and improvements required.• Developing the necessary changes to implement the updates and improvements required.• Providing technical support to the EUROMOD users.• Coordinating with the local ICT department to assure the compatibility and compliance of the EUROMOD application with the European Commission guidelines.• Drafting documentation for the ICT department and end-users
