This Unit carries out research in support of EU policies on migration and is responsible for the European Commission's Knowledge Centre on Migration and Demography.</p> <p>We are looking for a Trainee to contribute in providing support to the scientific and editorial tasks in the Migration and Demography Unit, in particular he/she will contribute to the activities of the Migration Profiles. The Migration Profiles aim at filling the knowledge gap on targeted information in the short-term in key third countries, by providing tailored and swift analysis fundamental for the response and monitoring of crisis situations, international relation progresses and migration movements.</p> <p>In detail, he/she will monitor migration and demography - related information, including potential stressors for migration at regional, national and sub-national level.</p> <p>The trainee would, under supervision of the Traineeship adviser, search for, collect, select, manage, analyse and eventually summarise information on some of the main countries of concern (mainly countries of origin in Africa) or at regional level. This will be based on open sources information (OSint) such as newspapers articles, reports, studies, public statements, and operational data at sub-national level.</p> <p>In addition, the trainee will be confronted with the interpretation of data provided by various sources. The trainee will be asked to help the execution of tasks related to the compilation of infographics and editorial tasks.</p>
