Further information is available at: http://www.jrc.ec.europa.eu</p> <p>Short description of activity:</p> <p>The Land Resources Unit of the Sustainable Resources Directorate is looking for a highly motivated trainee with economic studies to support the Raw Materials Project.</p> <p>The Raw Materials project provides science-based policy support in relation to the sustainable and secure supply of raw materials to the EU; both primary materials from extraction or harvesting and secondary materials from e.g. recycling. The project is implemented by a multi-disciplinary team addressing social, environmental, and economic considerations at EU and global scales. Key support activities include inputs to the analysis of raw materials that are critical to the EU economy but with a high risk of supply disruptions (http://rmis.jrc.ec.europa.eu/?page_id=22), development of the Raw Materials Scoreboard (http://rmis.jrc.ec.europa.eu/Scoreboard/), development of the Raw Materials Information System (http://rmis.jrc.ec.europa.eu/), as well as other sustainability and security-of-supply analyses.</p> <p>In particular, the trainee, under the supervision of the Traineeship adviser, will contribute to the development of analysis on economics and trade aspects of raw materials supply chains, particularly supporting activities related to critical raw materials and base metals markets.</p>
