Specific focus of the traineeship will be on analysing and reporting the contribution of chemical emissions listed in the 25 PEF pilot + BOP on 'Human and Aquatic toxicity' impact categories using the USEtox model. The trainee will also provide support for improving the reporting of toxicity score in PEF.
