The Contract Agent will be responsible for the follow-up and review of the energy/power market developments at EU and MSs levels.

The tasks will include:

- The production of a monthly newsletter flagging developments with relevance to the Energy Union strategy, its policies and associated activities.
- Following-up and synthesising the views of influential think-tanks on relevant policy issues.
- Proposition of topics to be considered in the work agenda of Dir C and JRC, at large.
- Liaising with and contributing to the European Semester work.

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate should have a completed university degree in Economics, Engineering, Political Science of at least three years attested by a diploma and at least five years of professional experience in energy related stakeholder management or energy policy related research or, alternatively should have a PhD degree preferably with research experience in relevant fields.

The candidate should have the ability to identify research, understand, critically analyse, and present policy relevant knowledge and information of concern to the EU's power market and energy internal market at large. A good understanding of the Energy Union political issues at stake its objectives and state-of-play of its advancement is essential.

It will be critical to meet deadlines and prioritise a varied and substantial workload. We expect a team playing mindset with a good sense of judgement and with excellent drafting and well-developed communication skills.
