<p>Position for:</p> <p>FG IV – Project Officer</p>	<p>As the science and knowledge service of the Commission, the mission of DG Joint Research Centre is to support EU policies with independent evidence throughout the whole policy cycle.</p> <p>The JRC is located in 5 Member States (Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Spain). The mission of the unit is to provide information and to support policies addressing land use demands, sustainable land-related natural resources and ecosystem services. Particular attention is given to land resources scarcity and conflicts, land degradation and desertification and to EU policies on soil, security of supply of raw materials and their supply chains, criticality, sustainability and monitoring of primary and secondary raw materials and ecosystem services accounting and evaluation. The unit is responsible also for further developing the European Commission's Raw Materials Information System, the EU List for Critical Raw Materials and the implementation of actions in the European Innovation Partnership for Raw Materials. The project is implemented by a multi-disciplinary team addressing social, environmental, and economic considerations at EU and global scales.</p> <p>The position will support the Raw Materials Project.
