The Directorate provides scientific knowledge for EU policies related to the sustainable use of resources, encompassing environmental, economic and social dimensions.</p> <p>As part of the Food Security Unit, the candidate will contribute to in-season crop monitoring and yield forecasting activities. Besides acting as agricultural analyst for the regular crop yield assessment reports, the task focuses on the characterization of crop growing conditions with focus on the susceptibility to pests and diseases during crucial phases of crop development, in order to further constrain the forecasts of crop yield along the growing season. In particular, the candidate will contribute to the development, testing, and implementation of methodologies to simulate the impact of pests and diseases on crop development and yield formation through advanced use of crop growth models.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>The ideal candidate will have a University degree and/or MSc and/or PhD in Agronomy, Agro-Meteorology, Environmental Modelling or a closely related field and a minimum of 5 years of professional experience after the first degree. Good knowledge of European agriculture and experience in using crop monitoring techniques are required. Professional experience in applying, analysing, and further developing crop growth models at code level is essential.</p> <p>Knowledge and experience in intra-season yield forecasting and agro-meteorological analysis is an asset. Experience in assessing crop quality and the impacts of pests and diseases on crop development are strong advantages.</p> <p>Good knowledge of spoken and written English (B2) is required. The knowledge of another community language would be an advantage.</p> <p>Relevant publications and presentations should be highlighted.</p>
