Within the unit, the sector radiation protection - to which the position is assigned - is in charge of the clearance measurements performed by gamma spectrometry.</p> <p>Qualifications: The job holder has to perform gamma spectrometry measurements according to the procedure of material release based on the German radiation protection law. The measurements must be carried out and documented according to the exact specifications of JRC and the national Technical Inspection Authority (TÜV) experts. The successful candidate should ideally have education in one of the following fields such as physics (general), generic and inorganic chemistry, nuclear energy, radioactivity and work with nuclear material or similar and a job-related experience of at least 2 years. She/he should have good knowledge of German (B1) and English (B1).</p>
