The mission of the Resource Planning unit is to do the multi-annual planning of human and financial resources required for the JRC's activities as well as corporate reporting and to coordinate the strategic development and planning of the JRC support, research and ICT infrastructure.

The ICT Programme Office is part of the unit and its mission is to consolidate/centralise the ICT investments in JRC and ensure a corporate approach towards ICT taking into account the specific needs of JRC.

We propose a position for an ICT Programme Officer, part of a small team, which is responsible to assist the governance bodies of JRC, in order to monitor the implementation of the JRC ICT architecture and identify potential needs for evolution.

The ICT Programme Officer will analyse all needs in ICT investments and will examine all new ICT proposals for investments in infrastructure and strive for consolidation of application development by issuing recommendations on coherence/integration. S/he will collaborate with the corporate ICT governance at the level of the Commission and will be for JRC the unique point of contact with the corporate ICT governance for what concerns the submission of ICT projects.

This is a dynamic and very interesting position, providing plenty of room for initiative and responsibility. As member of ICT Programme Office there will be the need to liaise with the JRC Directorates and Units, in order to ensure optimisation of the ICT resources. The work involves many contacts inside JRC and outside JRC with DIGIT, DG COMM and SG.

Qualifications:

We are looking for a motivated and service-oriented person able to work in close collaboration with various ICT services inside and outside of JRC. The candidate must have excellent diplomatic, organisational and analytical skills, combined with a capacity and enthusiastic and proactive approach for resolving issues and finding solutions in a complex environment.

S/he must have at least 3 years of experience with information technologies in the scientific area and at least 2 years with project management and leadership in an international environment.
