The Competence Centre is uniquely placed. Collaborating with over 20 Directorates of the European Commission, it currently covers four strands of activities: the Commission's modelling inventory and knowledge management system; baseline scenarios for integrated policy assessment; model quality and sensitivity analysis; and social multi-criteria evaluation.</p> <p>The successful candidate is expected to contribute to the development and running of the Modelling Inventory and Knowledge Management System of the European Commission (MIDAS). In addition the candidate is expected to contribute to the design, implementation and promotion of Better Regulation solutions and tools that enhance transparency, accountability, and reproducibility in policy making.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>Candidates will have a background in computer/data science and or modelling for policy making such as impact assessments or policy evaluation.
