Within the unit, the group decommissioning and waste management - to which the position is assigned – manages the measurement facilities for decommissioning and waste management and generates documentation of radioactive waste in compliance with acceptance criteria for transfer to intermediate storage and final disposal.</p> <p>Qualifications: The jobholder will carry out the radiation protection related tasks of the move of laboratories, from planning to coordination. This also includes the preparation of the related documentation.</p> <p>The successful candidate should ideally have a degree in physics, chemistry or related fields or a corresponding technical education with a job-related experience of at least 3 years. Knowledge and experience in laboratory work and work with radioactivity and nuclear material is essential. A job-specific training and an introduction to the Commission's IT tools will be provided. Solid knowledge of English (B2) and German (C1) is required.</p>
