He/she will also be involved in the planning and execution of projects.</p> <p>The successful candidate must have experience in technical and laboratory work as well as building maintenance and mechanics; knowledge in electronics would be an asset. A job-specific training and an introduction to the Commission's IT tools will be provided. She/he should have solid knowledge of English (B2) and German (B2).</p>
