The European Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control Bureau (EIPPCB), as part of the Unit "Circular Economy and Industrial Leadership", is looking for a researcher to contribute to the review of the Best Available Techniques reference documents (BREF) on Ceramics (CER). The Bureau supports the implementation of the EU's Industrial Emissions Directive (IED, 2010/75/EU) one of the Community's key instruments for ensuring sustainable production and environmental protection. Best Available Technique reference Documents (BREFs) are developed by the Bureau in consultation with stakeholders and adopted by the Commission and then published for use in the Member States. The successful candidate is expected to assist with the review of the Ceramics (CER) BREF, to participate in large expert meetings and manage all related information flow.

He/she will have following duties:

- steer the technical discussion/exchange of information with stakeholders on issues of interest to the review of the BREF;
- research information relevant to the BREF and analyse and validate/peer reviewed information provided by stakeholders;
- draft the BREF document based on the information.

Qualifications:

We are looking for an engineer, a chemist or a scientist with a good knowledge of industrial processes and related environmental issues in one or more of the areas covered by the IED (ex IPPC Directive). For this post it is essential to have a good understanding of process engineering, environmental issues and regulation of industry; an understanding of environmental policy in the EU; a thorough knowledge of the IED/IPPCC Directives and the concepts within. Knowledge of the Ceramics sector is a plus. It is important to have an open mind and positive attitude with the ability to assess submitted information and to be able to participate in expert discussions and meetings. The successful candidate will be self-motivated, be able to meet project deadlines and be a strong team player.

S/he must have at the time of applying a PhD or 5 years' research experience after university studies of at least 3 years attested by a diploma.

A very good level of written and spoken English is essential and knowledge of at least another EU language is compulsory.
