<p>Position for:</p> <p>FGIV- Programme Officer – Scientific Research</p>	<p>As the science and knowledge service of the Commission, the mission of DG Joint Research Centre is to support EU policies with independent evidence throughout the whole policy cycle.</p> <p>The JRC is located in 5 Member States (Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Spain). Further information is available at: https://ec.europa.eu/jrc/</p> <p>The Sustainable Transport Unit of the Energy, Transport and Climate Directorate of the JRC is carrying out scientific research and technical policy support on clean and efficient vehicles for sustainable mobility.</p> <p>The JRC is developing and managing the Transport Research and Innovation Monitoring and Information System (TRIMIS - https://trimis.ec.europa.eu/). TRIMIS is the analytical tool supporting the implementation and further development of the European Commission Strategic Transport Research and Innovation Agenda (STRIA). This tool is the Commission's instrument for mapping technology trends and research and innovation capacities in the transport field.</p> <p>In this context, an expert is needed with a broad profile capable to follow and monitor research and techno-economic progress in the transport sector and to map transport innovation. The work will include the development of a transport R&I scoreboard, data visualisation, definition of indicators to measure innovation progress, monitoring of modelling activities of specific transport technologies to ensure that R&I and technology trends are properly reflected in transport models used by the JRC and the EC. It will also include dissemination activities.</p> <p>The work will be carried out in close collaboration with colleagues within the Sustainable Transport Unit and other units/Directorates of the JRC. The preparation of reports and scientific publications are an integral part of the required tasks. It also involves contacts and managing networks within and outside the Commission.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>The ideal candidate should have a university degree in transport related engineering, economics or science and at least 3 years of relevant experience after the first degree giving access to doctoral studies.</p> <p>A broad familiarity and experience with transport research and innovation and related policy issues is essential.</p> <p>Knowledge of transport models (e.g. TREMOVE, Transtools, Model-T, Fleets models, etc.) and current data visualisation techniques is an asset.</p> <p>We look for a person with experience and strong interest in</p>
