The current vacancy is located at the JRC, Ispra site (Italy).</p> <p>The Knowledge for Security and Migration Unit is looking for a project officer who will be in charge of managing analysis and development work related to the creation of a Global Trends data tool. This tool currently includes a wide variety of economic and social facts, figures and trends for all African countries and the intention is to extend it to full global coverage. A large number of DG DEVCO departments will use the Data Tool, and as such, there is a need to improve its data visualisations, introduce interactivity and access to the full data sets in the background, help analyse the data, and produce narratives and communication outputs. The tool will create linkages to Sustainable Development Goals related work in the JRC and the JRC Task Force for Africa, including also funding flows in the context of Total Official Support for Sustainable Development (TOSSD) framework of the OECD.
