<p>Position for:</p> <p>FGIV- Project Officer</p>	<p>As the science and knowledge service of the Commission, the mission of DG Joint Research Centre is to support EU policies with independent evidence throughout the whole policy cycle.</p> <p>The JRC is located in 5 Member States (Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Spain). Further information is available at: https://ec.europa.eu/jrc/</p> <p>The Water and Marine Resources Unit of Directorate for Sustainable Resources has a central role in the scientific advice provision as it constitutes the STECF secretariat. It is assigned to support the Data Collection Framework (DCF) and has a unique role in carrying out research under the Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) remit.</p> <p>The Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) is a major EU policy framework, with significant political, socio-economic and environmental impact. It is also exceptional in that the provision of scientific advice is required by legislation through the Scientific, Economic and Technical Committee for Fisheries (STECF). Additionally, acknowledging the need for scientific data, the Data Collection Framework (DCF), requests Member States to submit fisheries data to the European Commission.</p> <p>The Data Collection Framework is typically used in fisheries modelling frameworks developed by the JRC for stock assessment, bioeconomic analysis and Management Strategy Evaluation. In all these areas major knowledge gaps persist, and the CFP relies to a great extent on the provision of advice produced by the JRC.</p> <p>Moreover the unit research focus on fisheries and aquaculture is renowned for the development of novel approaches underpinning sustainable and profitable fisheries management, fish stock assessment, control/enforcement and socio-economics.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>To maintain the unique role the JRC plays in the provision of scientific advice to the implementation of the CFP, the unit is selecting a fisheries scientist with a proven solid expertise of at least three years in stock assessment and fisheries modelling, and experience in communicating scientific analysis to fisheries managers and policy makers.</p> <p>A good level of English (B2) is required.</p>
