<p>Position for:</p> <p>FGIV – Evaluation Officer</p>	<p>As the science and knowledge service of the Commission, the mission of DG Joint Research Centre is to support EU policies with independent evidence throughout the whole policy cycle.</p> <p>The JRC is located in 5 Member States (Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Spain). Further information is available at: https://ec.europa.eu/jrc/</p> <p>The mission of the unit is to coordinate the JRC's planning and reporting under the Commission Strategic Planning and Programming (SPP), to coordinate evaluations, to monitor the implementation of risk management and internal control standards, and to steer the implementation of the integrated management system.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance and Evaluation Unit is looking for an evaluation officer who will provide methodological support to the further development of evaluation activities inside the JRC, and who will assist with the implementation of the evaluation tools. The evaluation activities are concerned with gathering and assessing quantitative and qualitative evidence for the impact of JRC's research on science, policy-making and society at large. Tools to be developed further include impact planning, monitoring (logging), case studies and the methodologies for their assessment. Training of JRC staff is an integral part of the duties. The job involves close cooperation with JRC scientists, policy DGs and external experts.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>Candidates should have a university degree in science, engineering, economics or political science (related to impact assessment or evaluation). A job related experience such as participation in impact assessments or evaluation of at least two years is required. Training/experience in using specific methodologies such as logical framework analysis or impact mapping, or in drafting case studies for evaluation purposes would be an advantage.</p> <p>A good knowledge of English (B2) is required.</p>
