In particular, the development of an EU indicator on landscape features, contributing to the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) impact indicator on share of landscape features in agricultural land.</p> <p>The work will consist in methodological developments for the impact landscape indicator as part of the Performance Monitoring and Evaluation Framework of the CAP. It shall provide technical support for the planning and execution of the Eurostat LUCAS landscape features statistical survey and for the analysis of the results. It shall also carry-out methodological developments to analyse the complementarity between remote sensing information and the LUCAS landscape in-situ data as well as for evaluating available datasets on landscape features in the Member States.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>At least a university degree (giving access to doctoral studies) and 5 years of professional experience after the university in the field of spatial-data analysis, geo-spatial statistics.</p> <p>Experience with advanced exploitation of remote sensing</p>
