The unit operates two accelerator laboratories, and three nuclear laboratories. The Health Physics Service has 9 staff.</p> <p>We look for a suitable candidate who can execute the tasks of Radiation Protection Officer as defined in COUNCIL DIRECTIVE 2013/59/EURATOM of 5 December 2013 and who can contribute to the Health Physics Service at JRC-Geel. The Assistant will be the HPS responsible for the surveillance of the activities of Unit G.2 at the GELINA and MONNET accelerator laboratories (controlled area) and will be a backup RPO for the on-site nuclear laboratories</p> <p>The selected candidate will carry out the following tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Monitor safety regulations and ensure work with radiation is carried out in accordance with the requirements.• Perform dose rate and contamination measurements.• Maintain adequate records of radiation sources.• Verify proper working and maintenance of survey instruments and assess periodically the condition of safety and warning systems.• Advise and assist scientific-technical staff in safety, radiation protection and waste management issues.• Introduce and train new workers to rules and procedures; inform, train and refresh workers about rules and changes.• Establish work plans; advice and comment on work plans, risk assessments and preventive measures for nuclear controlled area activities.• Participate in arranging prevention, preparedness and response for emergency exposure situations.• Liaise with the Qualified Expert.
