The mission of the Unit is to support the harmonised implementation of food and feed legislation through the provision of reliable measurement solutions and standards for evidence-based decision-making on the safety of the food chain. The mandate of the Unit is currently being expanded to include the compliance of products/materials in contact with drinking water.</p> <p>We propose a Contractual Agent position in Ispra, Italy. The successful candidate will contribute to the implementation of the recast Drinking Water Directive, in particular concerning the safe use of materials in contact with drinking water (Art. 11). The candidate will evaluate the performance characteristics of existing and new analytical/test methods for substances to be authorised in EU drinking water legislation and contribute to drafting JRC method evaluation reports and documents in support to possible method standardisation needs or definition of implementing/delegated acts.</p> <p>This challenging job in a dynamic setting involves frequent interactions with other Commission Directorates-General and decentralised agencies (ECHA, EFSA). The candidate will perform desk type work, with no laboratory activity foreseen.</p> <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>The candidate shall have a background in analytical chemistry, food science, environmental science, or a similar discipline. At least 3 years' experience in laboratory research methodologies and analytical measurements after the university diploma is required.</p> <p>Knowledge of food safety legislation in the EU and in the Member States and familiarity with drinking water materials and/or food contact materials is an advantage, as well as experience in standardisation.</p> <p>The candidate should have an open mind and positive attitude, with the ability to interact in an international context with Commission services, Agencies, Member State authorities, or other representatives. The candidate is able to lead expert discussions and meetings, is self-motivated, team player and</p>
