WE PROPOSE:

We are looking for an economist to support the implementation of European Union Blue Growth Strategy and related policies.

The candidate should have a committed, well-organized and dynamic personality, be open to explore new fields and pro-actively interact with different disciplines. S/he should also possess excellent communication skills.

S/he will carry out scientific work focussing on the enhancement of the JRC Blue Economy analysis and the development of the European Union Blue Economy Observatory. The work also includes a strong communication and dissemination component.

The assignment entails:

- Socio-economic analysis of Blue Economy sectors;
- Development of a European Union Blue Economy Observatory;
- Collaborating with a variety of research teams and stakeholders inside and outside the European Commission;
- Organising meetings and stakeholder consultations;
- Supporting policy analysis and policy impact assessments;
- Produce technical reports, scientific publications and policy briefs.

WE LOOK FOR:

The ideal candidate should have a PhD in economics or an equivalent field (or a University degree in economics and 5 years of relevant experience after the university degree) and excellent knowledge of Blue Economy activities and their analysis.

Excellent writing, presentation and dissemination skills, with proven experience in modern communication technologies and approaches is a strong asset.

Good knowledge of spoken and written English (minimum B2) are required. Relevant publications and presentations are seen as essential and should be highlighted. As assets will be considered experience in the management of projects, excellent analytical and computer skills, knowledge of relevant EU policies.

INDICATIVE CONTRACT'S DURATION:

24 months initial contract with possible renewals up to maximum 6 years.
