The current vacancy is in the Knowledge Management Methodologies, Communities and Dissemination Unit of the Directorate for Knowledge Management. The Unit is responsible for setting up the corporate processes and tools to support the work of the knowledge management units, in particular to ensure access to thematic knowledge in support of priority policy areas to the relevant Commission Services; coordinating and facilitating best practice of the activities of the knowledge management units; managing the JRC Science Hub, Connected, PUBSY and the eLibrary; coordinating with Commission services the establishment of corporate knowledge management processes, platforms and best practices; supporting relevant communication and training activities including the organisation of training for colleagues from policy DGs where relevant.

WE PROPOSE:

A position for a Graphic Designer / Video and Animation.

The position aims to disseminate Scientific Knowledge in support to policy making through the creation of graphically powerful videos and animations.

The new colleague will be responsible for the production of multimedia pieces, in line with the visual identity rules of the European Commission. The tasks include:

- Plan and develop audiovisual products (video clips, trailers, animations, motion graphics and other related multimedia products) for communicating about JRC science in line with European political priorities, in close collaboration with the visuals communication team.
- Assist in providing operational units with expertise, guidance, advice on complementary resources in the field of visual communication
- Create designs, concepts, and sample layouts based on knowledge of layout principles and aesthetic design concepts for Web and Social Media
- Provide support for the conception of dissemination plans for multimedia products.
- Maintain and further develop contacts with stakeholders, aiming at establishing and developing the necessary synergies in the audio-visual sector.

WE LOOK FOR:

We look for an enthusiastic, motivated, organized and pro-active colleague, who should have at least 2 years of experience in video editing, motion design and animation creation.

A relevant degree in audio-visual communication is required. Essential is knowledge of IT tools for video and animation production and editing.

The ideal candidate has eye for detail and has excellent communication skills, and has the ability to work in a team and deliver high quality work in a structured way. A very good knowledge of English (C1) is also required. **Candidates are required to include a link to their online portfolio in their application.**

INDICATIVE CONTRACT'S DURATION:

36 months initial contract with possible renewals up to maximum 6 years.
