The current vacancy is in the Infrastructure unit which is part of the Site Management Ispra Department of the Support Services Directorate, and namely in the Group in charge of Construction Projects.

The Support Services Directorate of the DG JRC ensures the efficient and effective deployment of the resources necessary to support the JRC's activities, in compliance with all applicable rules and regulations and to make the JRC sites safe, secure and attractive working environments by providing efficient customer-driven services to facilitate the current and future scientific activities of the JRC while ensuring that JRC sites act as a good neighbour to their respective communities at large.

The mission of the Site Management Ispra Department and in particular of the Infrastructure unit, is to make the Ispra site a modern, attractive and effective place to work identifying and ensuring the application of the appropriate safety, security and environmental procedures and measures for the Ispra site.

WE PROPOSE:

An architect/engineer position to act as project leader for a number of infrastructure projects (construction, refurbishment or demolition works).

The jobholder will take the role of Project Leader for a number of projects in the group in charge of the design and construction of buildings and technical installations for the general infrastructure of JRC-Ispra site. The Project Leader is in particular responsible for the overall control of the quality of the executed projects and the control of progress in terms of time and costs. Main tasks will involve:

- Control the technical progress of the projects and ensure full respect of all applicable safety standards during the works.
- Guarantee the best possible service for end-users.
- Check the correct implementation of contracts or framework contracts used on construction projects.
- Prepare technical specifications for call for tenders.
- Estimate budget needs for new projects.
- Monitor and respect allocated budget when implementing projects.

WE LOOK FOR:

A committed candidate having a minimum of 5 years' experience in construction design or engineering, a good understanding of heating, ventilation and air-conditioning and of electrical installation, as well as a level of education which corresponds to completed university studies in architecture or mechanical or electrical engineering or related domain attested by a diploma. Designing skills combined with Autocad perfect knowledge is required.

An experience in contract management is highly desirable. An experience in energy efficiency would be appreciated in view of implementation of the Green Deal. Knowledge of EMAS certification is an asset. Experience with internationally renowned certification methodologies like BREEAM is an advantage. Good command of REVIT will be appreciated.

The nature of the duties requires a very good (B2) knowledge of English and Italian (for the interaction with external contractors).

INDICATIVE CONTRACT'S DURATION:

36 months initial contract with possible renewals up to maximum 6 years.
