- Supervise the publication of reports on NDWM.

WE LOOK FOR:

The ideal candidate shall have a professional in depth experience of at least 5 years related to the nature of the duties, in particular in the field of nuclear decommissioning and waste management.

Knowledge and experience in international knowledge management initiatives in the nuclear field would be an advantage. Attitude in interacting with stakeholders in an international and multicultural environment would be an asset.
