The Unit supports EU policies on consumers, food safety and health by mapping, collating, analysing, quality checking and communicating in a systematic and comprehensible way all the relevant scientific data, methods, tools and knowledge available worldwide in their policy area.

The Directorate and unit are located in both Ispra and Geel; the current position is located in Ispra.

WE PROPOSE:

We are looking for an experienced Communication Officer to join the Knowledge Management Team of the Directorate.

The role is a key position, supporting and coordinating the communication activities of the Directorate, in close contact with the Office of the Director and the central communication services. The selected candidate will work directly with scientists from the Directorate, working on editing text for online publication, providing input for social media, relations with the JRC press team, etc.

The selected candidate will also act as the Directorate liaison for communication.

WE LOOK FOR:

The ideal candidate should have:

- A level of education which corresponds to a completed university studies of at least three years attested by a diploma in relevant field.
- Excellent drafting skills and experience in translating complex scientific content to easy-to-read communications.
- Experience working on scientific topics, translation content for easy online reading.
- Experience with web content management systems.
- Knowledge of English at minimum C1 level. Knowledge of Italian and/or Dutch is considered an advantage.
- Good organising skills and networking skills.

INDICATIVE CONTRACT'S DURATION:

36 months initial contract with possible renewals up to maximum 6 years.
