Within the unit, the sector Radiation Protection - to which the position is assigned – manages the safe operation of the nuclear site.

WE PROPOSE:

The jobholder will have to assist the sector Radiation protection according to safety and security standards. He/she will contribute to tasks on radiation protection on-site (measurements, measurement equipment, documentation).

WE LOOK FOR:

The successful candidate shall have:

- A level of post-secondary education attested by a diploma in a technical field (engineering or equivalent) or in a field related to radiation protection, or alternatively a level of secondary education attested by a diploma giving access to post-secondary education and appropriate professional experience of at least 3 years.
- Job-related experience of at least 3 years in working with radioactive material, preferably in a laboratory is desirable.
- Language skills: good knowledge in German and/or English is required; the other language would be an asset.

A job-specific training and an introduction to the Commission's IT tools will be provided.

36 months initial contract with possible renewals up to maximum 6 years.
