The current vacancy is within the Infrastructure Unit in Ispra, namely in the Energy Management and Utilities Group.

The mission of the Infrastructure unit is to make the Ispra site a modern, attractive and effective place to work by ensuring infrastructure services with the application of the appropriate safety, security and environmental requirements and measures.

The Unit is looking for a technician who will work within a team to ensure the operation and maintenance of the heating and air-conditioning plant of the Site.

We are a unit of 60 people in a dynamic working environment on the JRC site of Ispra. We are organised in different teams, and work very closely together across team borders. We embrace the culture of the JRC built on trust, collaboration and transparency.

WE PROPOSE

The jobholder will work within a team to ensure the operation and maintenance of the heating and air-conditioning installations of the Site.

The main tasks are:

- Ensure the necessary interventions for the operation of the installations.
- Diagnose system malfunctions to restore the operative effectiveness of air-conditioning installations.
- Verify the operation of the systems in the context of programmed maintenance and, if necessary, carry out extraordinary works.
- Program and supervise works executed by the external companies.



- Carry out installation of infrastructure parts in new laboratories.
- Perform the necessary actions in order to guarantee the operational effectiveness of all installations.
- Contribute to the development and application of environment, health and safety in the workplace provision.
- Apply the safety procedures and quality work instructions.

WE LOOK FOR

We are looking for a motivated dynamic colleague with at least 3 years of experience in the management and maintenance of technical installations and in particular heating and air-conditioning installations.

The position requires an excellent teamwork spirit, a culture of service, a sense of efficiency and the need of being included in rounds of on-call availability; ability to manage problems and unforeseen events that can alter the normal functioning of the plants, possibly communicating the anomaly to the technicians and competent managers.

The nature of the duties requires a good level (B2) of Italian (for the interaction with external contractors); knowledge of English or French will be an advantage for relations with the occupants of the buildings.
