WE PROPOSE

A position of Health and Safety officer. The jobholder will act as deputy Safety Officers Coordinator (RSPP) for the people and infrastructure of the Ispra Site and will coordinate the



different and relevant Safety Office's management systems in place (ISO 45001) and contributes to the others if required (ISO 9001, ISO 14001, EMAS).

S/he will support on operational safety related issues by means of identification of hazards, assessment of risks and issue and follow-up of action plans, identification of safety measures for workplaces, selection of monitoring tools of safety measures, definition of safety training and information needs for workers.

The candidate will support JRC Ispra Safety Officers, Safety technicians and Fire Pickets by circulating information, stimulating discussions, agreeing on common actions and implementing harmonized solutions and as ASPP (Occupational Health and Safety Technician) for the people and infrastructures on the Ispra site.

WE LOOK FOR

We are looking for a motivated and dynamic person able to adapt to a dynamic environment and work. The minimum requirements of the candidate are:

- Being a certified RSPD for at least 2 years is essential
- At least 5 years of Experience in Safety related field is essential
- At least 3 years of Experience as ASPP or RSPD for activities related to two or more ATECO Macro-sectors would be an advantage.
- At least 1 year of experience as ASPP/RSPD for activities in the field of chemistry, biologic, nuclear or construction would be an advantage.
- At least 2 years of experience in management of Management System OHSAS 18001 or ISO 45001 would be an advantage.
- Very good knowledge of spoken and written English (level B2).
- Very good knowledge of spoken and written Italian (level B2).
