<p><b>Position for: CATEGORY 30</b></p>	<p>The Information Society (IS) Unit has a vacancy for a post-doctoral researcher to work in the Action called "Socio-economic Analysis of ICT for Learning and Inclusion", in particular in the area of "ICT for Social Innovation and Social Inclusion".</p> <p>This area focuses on investigating, from a technological, socio-economic, organisational, and policy point of view, the current use and impact of existing and emerging ICT enabled (social) innovations for employability, employment and social inclusion of disadvantaged groups from qualitative and quantitative perspectives. It aims at providing support to the design, implementation and monitoring of social and employment policies.</p> <p>The successful candidate should demonstrate knowledge and/or experience in social, economic and/or innovation related research on "ICT for inclusion". Experience in evidence-based policy research would be an asset. Knowledge of the following would be an advantage: quantitative and/or qualitative methods, innovation, evaluation methods and ICT impact analysis.</p> <p>The successful candidate should be able to make use of a range of methods (literature review, data collection and analysis, surveys, focus-groups, interviews, etc.) to develop policy support at European level, as well as to review and write reports and articles, launch, coordinate and manage research work, participate in research projects and scientific seminars/workshops and represent the IPTS at international conferences.</p> <p>Qualifications: CAT. 30: The ideal candidate should have a Ph.D. or a minimum of 5 years of research experience after the first degree giving access to doctoral studies. A very good level of written and spoken English is essential.</p>
