Knowledge on quantitative and/or qualitative methods, economics of education, evaluation and assessment methods, ICT impact analysis and/or foresight would be an asset.</p> <p>The successful candidate should be able to make use of a range of methods (literature review, data collection and analysis, surveys, focus-groups, interviews, etc.) to develop policy support at European level, as well as to review and write reports and articles, participate in research projects and scientific seminars/workshops and represent the IPTS at international conferences.</p> <p>Qualifications: CAT. 30: The ideal candidate should have a Ph.D. or a minimum of 5 years of research experience after the first degree giving access to doctoral studies. A very good level of written and spoken English is essential and knowledge of at least one other EU language is compulsory.</p>
