Further information is available at: http://www.jrc.ec.europa.eu</p> <p><u>Short description of activity:</u></p> <p>The European Alien Species Information Network (EASIN) facilitates the access to scientific information on alien species in different repositories and databases from a single web interface, enabling analysis of data through data exploration services and mapping tools.</p> <p>EASIN has been appointed as the information support system foreseen under Article 25 of the EU Regulation 1143/2014 on Invasive Alien Species (IAS), underpinning the implementation of the Regulation. In this context, EASIN Team will thoroughly review the scientific and grey (technical reports) literature, aiming to update the occurrences and geo-referenced spatial data of IAS.</p> <p>The data collected should feed EASIN-Lit, which is a geo-database providing access to data on species occurrences published in the literature.
