<p>Position for:</p> <p>Trainee</p>	<p>As the science and knowledge service of the Commission, the mission of Joint Research Centre is to support EU policies with independent evidence throughout the whole policy cycle.</p> <p>The JRC is located in 5 Member States (Belgium, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Spain). Further information is available at: http://www.jrc.ec.europa.eu</p> <p><u>Short description of activity:</u></p> <p>Within the JRC Food and Feed compliance Unit, a team is tasked with assisting the Directorate-General for Internal Market, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs (DG GROW) in developing and implementing policies for the upcoming European Union Product Compliance Network (EU PCN). Starting in January 2021, the Network will serve to increase cooperation and coordination between the national Market Surveillance Authorities (MSAs) across Europe, in every non-food product sector. The rapid evolution of the Single Market, with new economic operators and distribution channels entering the playfield, constitutes a challenge for public authorities tasked with ensuring the quality and safety of circulating goods. Therefore, a high level of collaboration among the MSAs becomes necessary, and every actor should be able to share their best practices and expertise with others.</p> <p>The trainee will learn by participating in several tasks connected to that, but the focus will be on the mapping of training needs of MSAs and developing options for a common long-term training programme to be implemented as part of the EU Product Compliance Network. The candidate shall have excellent organisational and team working skills, enthusiasm, ability to work in a multinational team, proactivity in learning concepts outside his/her area of expertise and a curious mind. Knowledge in the field of market surveillance is an asset, but is not mandatory. Some experience in organizing trainings/webinars/events is desirable.
