The traineeship is within the Health Promotion team of the Health in Society Unit. Health promotion is about 'the process of enabling people to increase control over, and to improve, their health'. Knowledge and best practices for primary prevention of cancer and other non-communicable diseases is a main topic. The team also supports the Farm to Fork Strategy objectives, in particular those related to promoting sustainable and healthy food preferences.
