Short description of activity:

Since 2013, one of its research units F1 is addressing priority activities such as nutrition, healthcare quality and health information on rare diseases and cancer.

With regard to the latter, the JRC coordinates the development of the European quality assurance (QA) scheme within the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer (ECIBC <https://healthcare-quality.jrc.ec.europa.eu/>).

The QA scheme is a collection of requirements based on evidence that can be followed by any breast cancer service wishing to improve the quality of care offered to women. The scheme is designed to be implemented on a voluntary basis. Before the full roll out of the QA scheme, some activities to test the feasibility of the QA scheme in real settings are foreseen.

In this context, the tasks assigned to the successful candidate will include:

- Under supervision, perform literature searches and extraction of information to support the update of the reference documents for the QA scheme
- Support the process of feasibility checks of the QA scheme in real settings
- Support the team in the preparation of materials for dissemination and in organising meetings or other events for the ECIBC

The candidate will support the JRC team dedicated to the project and he/she will have
