Further information is available at: <a href="http://www.jrc.ec.europa.eu">http://www.jrc.ec.europa.eu</a></p> <p><b><u>Short description of activity:</u></b></p> <p>The <b>KNOW4SDGs</b> project supports a comprehensive and systematic assessment of EU policies with respect to SDGs, to contribute to a mainstreaming of the SDGs in a European Policy context and to support policy makers in contextualizing their policies within the SDG framework with qualitative and quantitative assessments.</p> <p>Within this project, one of the objectives is to assess synergies and trade-offs among different SDGs, unveiling interlinkages and anticipating possible direct and indirect links among SDGs. Another important objective of JRC work is to contribute to enhance communication to citizens and increase their engagement on SDGs, developing tools to raise awareness about SDG framework.</p> <p>A dedicated tool to display <b>SDG interlinkages</b> (synergies and trade-offs) is currently being developed, based on a structured literature review. The selected candidate is expected to complete data analysis from the identified relevant literature and structure the results based on different geographical, thematic and temporal contexts, and propose methods to visualise results. Furthermore, the candidate will support the SDGs team in the creation of public material and graphical visualisation tools to make JRC research and results on SDGs more visible and available through the KnowSDGs platform (<a href="https://knowsdgs.jrc.ec.europa.eu/">https://knowsdgs.jrc.ec.europa.eu/</a>).</p>
