<p>Position for:</p> <p>Trainee</p>	<p><u>Short description of activity:</u> The overall objective of the SCOEL support project is to develop at the JRC Institute of Health and Consumers Protection (IHCP), an infrastructure that provides technical and scientific services to DG EMPL and to the SCOEL in the area of Occupational Exposure Limit Values (OELVs) for individual hazardous chemicals in the workplace in accordance with article 3 of Directive 98/24/EC on chemical agents and Directive 2004/37/EC on carcinogens and mutagens.</p> <p><u>Qualifications:</u> The ideal candidate should have at least 1 year of research experience after the first degree giving access to doctoral studies.</p> <p>The candidate should have a background in toxicology, chemistry, environmental science, biology, or similar discipline and should have a pronounced interest to carry out research in the area of risk assessment.</p> <p>Practical experience in the area occupational health would be an asset. Ability to work in a multi-national team, creativity, consensus-building skills, positive spirit and capability to work independently is of importance. A good level of English (level B2) is required for the post.
