The Safety & Security of Buildings Unit is seeking a trainee to be integrated in the team dealing with the seismic risk and energy efficiency assessment of the urban building stock across the European Union.

The training consists in the collection and review of information regarding the economic cost associated to different levels of seismic damage in structural and non-structural elements of buildings across the seismic-prone countries of the European Union. The study intends to propose a damage-cost model for the estimation of monetary losses in the framework of a Europe-wide seismic risk assessment of buildings. The trainee will prepare a technical report at the end of his/her stay.

Qualifications:

Essentials:

Candidates must hold a University degree in civil/structural engineering and an MSc in a field relevant to the topic of the call. Applications from students currently preparing a thesis for an MSc degree are eligible. The thesis should match with the subject of the project call.

A good knowledge of the English language (level B2) is essential.
