The Safety & Security of Buildings Unit is seeking a trainee to be integrated in the team dealing with the seismic risk and energy efficiency assessment of the urban building stock across the European Union.

The training consists in the review of the building stock in EU Member States including: (1) development of an inventory and mapping of buildings according to established taxonomies regarding their energy efficiency and seismic performance; (2) collection of data on the current value of buildings. The trainee will prepare a technical report at the end of his/her stay.

Qualifications:

Essential:

Candidates must hold a University degree in civil/structural engineering and an MSc in a field relevant to the topic of the call.

Applications from students currently preparing a thesis for an MSc degree are eligible. The thesis should match with the subject of the project call.

A good knowledge of the English language (level B2) is essential.

Candidates must have good analysing and problem-solving skills.
