The Migration Profiles aim at filling the knowledge gap on targeted information in the short-term in key third countries, by providing tailored and swift analysis fundamental for the response and monitoring of crisis situations, international relation progresses and migration movements.</p> <p>In detail, he/she will monitor migration and demography - related information, including potential stressors for migration at regional, national and sub-national level.</p> <p>The task of the trainee, under the supervision of the Traineeship adviser, would be to search for, collect, select, manage, analyse and eventually summarise information on some of the main countries of concern (mainly countries of origin in Africa).</p> <p>This will predominantly be based on open sources information (OSint) such as newspapers articles, reports, studies, public statements, data collected at sub-national level.</p> <p>Other tasks may include the treatment and analysis</p>
