Short description of activity:

Areas of interest for this position include (but are not limited to) health care quality and public health. In particular, the trainee will support the Healthcare Quality team for some key activities related to European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer (ECIBC) and European Commission Initiative on Colorectal Cancer (ECICC).

These are person-centred initiatives aiming to improve and harmonise cancer screening and care in Europe via evidence-based guidelines and quality assurance schemes for the healthcare services involved in screening and care pathways.

Tasks include support to one of the following areas:

1) preparation of online surveys and searches for European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer and European Commission Initiative on Colorectal Cancer, following-up the respondents, collecting the responses in a database, as well as data analysis and contributing to the final report;

2) Guidelines development and life-cycle for the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer and European Commission Initiative on Colorectal Cancer;

3) Quality Assurance scheme development and piloting plans for the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer and European Commission Initiative on Colorectal Cancer;

4) Training template for Screening professionals for the European Commission Initiative on Breast Cancer and European Commission Initiative on Colorectal Cancer.
